Casting Notes from the author/director *IF ANY*

Casting Breakdown:

2 female presenting actors + 3 male presenting actors

- Tony Wendice M; English; 30s-40s Charismatic, and intelligent. Tony is a former writer who is plotting to murder his wife for financial gain. He should possess a suave and manipulative demeanor, capable of portraying both charm and menace.
- Margot Wendice F; English; 30s-40s Elegant, Margot is Tony's wife and the target of his murder plot. She is innocent, vulnerable, and caught in a dangerous situation. Margot should be able to showcase a range of emotions, from fear and confusion to determination and strength. There will be a demand on physical contact.
- Maxine Hadley- F; American; 30s-40s Maxine is a crime novelist and Margot's former lover. She becomes entangled in the murder plot when he discovers Tony's intentions. Max should exhibit intelligence, bravery, and a deep affection for Margot. She should have good chemistry with Margot to portray their complicated history.

- Lesgate M; English; 30s-40s- Captain Lesgate, also known as Swann, is a shady character hired by Tony to carry out the murder. He is a cunning and manipulative individual with a criminal background. Lesgate should be able to portray a sense of menace and desperation, with a hint of vulnerability / police constable come in at the end.
- Inspector Hubbard/BBC Interviewer M; English; 40s-50s Inspector Hubbard is a seasoned detective investigating the murder case. He is astute, observant, and persistent. Hubbard should exude a sense of authority and experience, while also displaying a dry wit and a sharp mind. BBC interviewer should have the relaxed tone of a radio interviewer.
