

TERMS TO KNOW

President of the United States (POTUS)

- Current POTUS: Joe Biden
- Responsibilities
 - Manage politics with other countries
 - Hire executive staff
 - Enforce federal laws
 - Supreme commander of the U.S. military
 - Recommend new laws to Congress
 - Hold Regular press conferences

First Lady of the United States (FLOTUS)

- Current FLOTUS: Jill Biden
- No formal responsibilities, but often leads public initiatives and has a strong media presence.

Chief of Staff

- Current Chief of Staff: Jeff Zients
- Responsibilities:
 - Help develop policies with the President
 - Oversee daily operations
 - Coordinate staff activities







TERMS TO KNOW

White House Press Secretary

- Current Press Secretary: Karine Jean-Pierre
- Responsibilities
 - Collect information about executive activities
 - Manage the relationship between POTUS and the media



President's Secretary

- Current President's Secretary: Julia Reed
- Responsibilities
 - Bookkeeping
 - Scheduling
 - Organizing correspondence (letters, phone calls, emails)

The Press Corps

- A group of journalists that report to news networks such as CNN, FOX, and ABC News
- Inform the public about President's actions and activities to ensure transparency and accountability



DURING THE SHOW
